- The Board met with our accountant at the last board meeting where we set our **budget** for the upcoming year. Unfortunately, we needed to make some adjustments, to ease the strain. You will see a \$10.00 increase in your sewer base rate and an .50 increase in your per 1000 gallons water usage starting in November. We haven't had an increase since 2003.
- New/revised Ordinances**– The board has been updating and creating ordinances for the Village. Recently we have adopted **Ordinance #485** for unsafe buildings. **Ordinance #487** requires ATV's and UTV's that are driven on the streets, to be registered with the village office. Please call for registration requirements and to get your sticker. We have updated other ordinances, please join us at a board meeting to stay current with Village business.
- Craig's town **motto** was a "A Step Back in Time". It's time for a new motto that represents who we are, please send your ideas to dnjhinman@nntc.net or to the clerks office for consideration.
- It's that time of year again when the **leaves** begin to fall. It is very helpful to keep your yards and storm drains free from leaves and grass clippings.
