

ORDINANCE NO. 204

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAIG, NEBRASKA, DECLARING THE FOLLOWING ACTS TO BE UNLAWFUL IN SAID VILLAGE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE COMMISSION THEREOF, VIZ: BEING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR OR UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF A NARCOTIC DRUG; DRINKING ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR ON THE STREETS OR ALLEYS OR ON PROPERTY USED OR OWNED BY THE UNITED STATES, THE STATE OF NEBRASKA, OR ANY GOVERNMENTAL SUBDIVISIONS THEREOF, OR IN THEATRES, DANCE HALLS OR OTHER PUBLIC PLACES; DISTURBING THE PEACE, QUARRELING, CURSING, SWEARING OR USING OBSCENE OR INDECENT LANGUAGE, ENGAGING IN RIOTOUS OR DISORDERLY CONDUCT, FIGHTING, STRIKING OR ASSAULTING ANOTHER IN A THREATENING MANNER; MALICIOUSLY MOLESTING, INJURING OR DESTROYING PROPERTY OF OTHERS; TRESPASSING ON PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PROPERTY; WINDOW PEEPING; LOITERING ON STREETS, ALLEYS, AND PUBLIC GROUNDS BY VAGRANTS; OPERATING OR PERMITTING GAMBLING DEVICES OR LOTTERIES; PARTICIPATING IN LOTTERIES OR GAMES OF CHANCE; ENGAGING IN PANDERING, PROSTITUTION OR ILLICIT SEXUAL INTERCOURSE; OPERATING HOUSE OF PROSTITUTION OR DISORDERLY HOUSE; MOLESTING FEMALES; INDECENT EXPOSURE OR DISPOSING IN ANY MANNER OF OBSCENE, LEWD, OR INDECENT BOOKS, PICTURES OR OTHER PUBLICATIONS, OR EXHIBITING OR PERFORMING ANY INDECENT, LEWD OR IMMORAL OR OBSCENE PLAY IN A PUBLIC PLACE OR WRITING, DRAWING PROFANE, OBSCENE, INDECENT OR LEWD WORDS, SENTENCES, FIGURES OR DESIGNS, SPITTING ON SIDEWALKS OR IN OTHER PUBLIC PLACES; CARRYING CONCEALED WEAPONS, DISCHARGING FIREARMS, AIRGUNS, OR SLINGSHOTS; RESISTING POLICE OFFICER OR REFUSING TO ASSIST SUCH OFFICER IN THE PERFORMANCE OF HIS DUTY; IMPERSONATING A POLICE OFFICER; BURNING TRASH OR OTHER MATERIAL ON CONCRETE STREETS, SIDEWALKS, CURB OR GUTTER OR ASPHALT PAVEMENT OR SCATTERING COMBUSTIBLE MATERIAL ON STREETS, ALLEYS OR PUBLIC GROUNDS; DIGGING IN STREETS WITHOUT PERMIT; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PRESCRIBING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAIG, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1 DRUNKENNESS; NARCOTIC DRUGS,
 UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF

It shall be unlawful for any person to be drunk or under the influence of intoxicating liquor or under the influence of a narcotic drug, within said Village.

SECTION 2 DRINKING ON STREETS; IN PUBLIC PLACES
OR ON PUBLIC PROPERTY

It shall be unlawful for any person to drink alcoholic liquor of any kind on the streets or alleys, or upon property used or owned by the United States, the State of Nebraska, or any governmental subdivision thereof, or in theatres, dance halls or in any other place open to or frequented by the public, within said Village.

SECTION 3 DISTURBING THE PEACE

It shall be unlawful for any person to disturb the peace and quiet of any person, family, neighborhood, or public assembly or to make any loud, boisterous or unusual noise, or to quarrel, curse, swear or use obscene or indecent language within said Village.

SECTION 4 DISORDERLY CONDUCT

It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in any riotous or disorderly conduct or fight, strike, assault another person in a threatening manner, or to do or engage in any other disorderly act within said Village.

SECTION 5 MALICIOUS DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY

It shall be unlawful for any person, wantonly or maliciously, in any manner to molest, injure, or destroy any property of another, in said Village.

SECTION 6 TRESPASSING

It shall be unlawful for any person to remain upon any private or public property, within said Village, without the express permission of the owner, or party in possession thereof.

SECTION 7 WINDOW PEEPING

It shall be unlawful for any person to maliciously or stealthily go upon the premises of another in said Village and look or peep into any window, door or other opening in any building located thereon which is occupied as a place of abode, or to go upon the premises

of another for the purpose of looking or peeping into any window, door or other opening in any building thereon which is occupied as a place of abode.

SECTION 8 VAGRANCY PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any vagrant to loiter or remain upon the streets, alleys or public grounds of said Village. A person shall be deemed to be a vagrant who has no visible means of support and lives without employment or wanders about from place to place begging or receiving alms.

SECTION 9 OPERATING GAMBLING DEVICES OR LOTTERY; PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate or permit to be operated in said Village any lottery, game of chance or gambling device of any kind, with the exception that bingo is permitted if operated pursuant to State law, on premises owned or occupied by him.

SECTION 10 GAMBLING PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any person to participate in any lottery or game of chance except bingo in said Village unless authorized and licensed by State law.

SECTION 11 PANDERING, PROSTITUTION, AND ILLICIT SEXUAL INTERCOURSE; PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in or commit any act of pandering, prostitution or illicit sexual intercourse within said Village.

SECTION 12 HOUSE OF PROSTITUTION; DISORDERLY HOUSE; PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any person to keep, operate or maintain or to be an inmate of or visit a house of prostitution or a disorderly house within said Village. A house of prostitution shall be construed to mean a house or other place which is kept, used, or operated

as a place for the commission of acts of sexual intercourse for hire. A disorderly house shall be construed to mean any place kept in such a manner as to disturb, annoy or scandalize the public generally or persons within the particular neighborhood, or any place used as a public resort by drunkards, prostitutes, or other idle or vicious persons or any place of public resort where illegal practices are habitually carried on to the corruption of public morals.

SECTION 13 MOLESTING FEMALES

It shall be unlawful for any male person to molest or force or attempt to force his presence or attention upon any female person against her desire or consent in said Village.

SECTION 14 INDECENT EXPOSURE OF PERSON; INDECENT BOOK, PICTURE, PLAY, DESIGN

It shall be unlawful for any person within said Village to make an indecent exposure of his or her person, or to commit any indecent or lewd act, or to sell or offer for sale, or to dispose of in any manner any obscene, lewd or indecent book, picture or other publication or thing, or to exhibit or perform any indecent, immoral, lewd or obscene play or other representation or in any public place to write, draw or make any profane, obscene, indecent or lewd work, sentence, figure, or design.

SECTION 15 SPITTING IN PUBLIC PLACES PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any person to spit on any sidewalk, or street crossing, or in any entryway to a building from the sidewalk space, or on any floor, wall, or stairway of any building within said Village.

SECTION 16 CARRYING CONCEALED WEAPONS; DISCHARGING FIREARMS, ETC., PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any person, except a police officer in the performance of his duties, to carry any dangerous weapons concealed on or about his person, his automobile, or elsewhere, or to discharge any firearm, airgun or slingshot loaded with rock or other dangerous missiles, within said Village; provided, this section

shall not apply to shooting galleries or other private shooting ranges within buildings or other structures approved by the Chairman and Board.

SECTION 17 RESISTING OR FAILING TO ASSIST
 AN OFFICER PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any person in said Village to hinder, obstruct or resist any police officer or policeman in making any arrest or performing any duty of his office, or to refuse or neglect to assist any such officer when called upon by him in the making of any arrest, or the conveying of a prisoner to jail.

SECTION 18 IMPERSONATING OFFICER PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any person in said Village other than a regular policeman or other authorized officer or employee of the Village to wear a badge similar to or resembling the badges prescribed for or furnished the police force or any other officer or employee of the Village, or to willfully impersonate, or endeavor to impersonate any such policeman, officer or employee or seek to exercise authority as such.

SECTION 19 STREET OR SIDEWALK OBSTRUCTIONS
 PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any person to place or leave, or cause to be placed or left, any article whatsoever upon any sidewalk, street, alley, or public place within said Village that will tend to obstruct the public use of the same or to cause any street, sidewalk or public place in said Village to become crowded with people so as to prevent or interfere with the free use of the same by the public.

SECTION 20 FIRES ON SIDEWALKS OR PAVEMENT;
 SCATTERING COMBUSTIBLE MATERIAL
 THEREON PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any person to burn any trash or any other material on any concrete or asphalt sidewalk, curb and gutter or concrete or asphalt pavement, or to scatter any combustible material of any kind on the streets, alleys or public ground in said Village.

SECTION 21 DIGGING IN STREETS WITHOUT PERMIT
PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any person to dig or make any excavation in the streets or alleys within said Village without first obtaining a written permit therefor from the Street Commissioner of the Village.

SECTION 22 PENALTY

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance upon conviction shall be fined not more than \$100.00 and pay the costs of prosecution.

SECTION 23 REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES

All ordinances and parts of ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage and approval of this ordinance and in conflict therewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 24 WHEN OPERATIVE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
