

ORDINANCE NO. 210

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAIG, NEBRASKA REQUIRING OCCUPANTS AND OWNERS OF PROPERTY IN SAID VILLAGE TO REMOVE SNOW AND ICE FROM THE ADJACENT SIDEWALKS, AND TO KEEP SUCH SIDEWALKS FREE FROM OVERHANGING BRANCHES AND LIMBS TO A HEIGHT OF SEVEN FEET AND FREE FROM ENCROACHING HEDGES OR SHRUBBERY; PROHIBITING ANY TREE, HEDGE OR SHRUBBERY CLOSER THAN EIGHTEEN INCHES TO THE SIDEWALK, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PRESCRIBING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAIG, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1 SIDEWALKS; DUTY TO REMOVE SNOW, SLEET AND ICE; PENALTY

It shall be the duty of the occupant of each lot or parcel of land in said village to remove all snow, sleet and ice from the sidewalks adjacent thereto within 24 hours after the same has accumulated thereon, and if snow, sleet or ice shall remain on any sidewalk for more than 24 hours it shall be the duty of the Street Commissioner to remove the same and the expense of such removal shall be charged to and collected from the occupant or owner of such property. Any such occupant or owner who fails to remove the snow, sleet, or ice, which shall have accumulated on the adjacent sidewalks, within the time aforesaid upon conviction shall be fined not more than \$10.00 and shall pay the costs of prosecution and the cost of the removal of such snow, sleet, or ice.

SECTION 2 SIDEWALKS; DUTY TO REMOVE BRANCHES AND SHRUBBERY ENCROACHING THEREON; PENALTY

It shall be the duty of the occupant of each lot or parcel of ground in said village to keep the sidewalk adjacent thereto free from overhanging branches and free from limbs to a height of seven feet, and to keep such sidewalk free from encroaching hedges or shrubbery and no tree, shrubbery or hedge shall be permitted closer than eighteen inches to the sidewalk. It shall be the duty of the occupant of each lot or parcel of ground abutting on any intersection, to trim and or remove any shrubbery, sign or other obstacle which obstructs the view for a distance of 10 feet from any

intersection. Any such occupant or owner who fails to remove the overhanging branches and limbs or other encroachments within three days after receiving written notice so to do, upon conviction shall be fined not more than \$10.00 and shall pay the costs of prosecution and the costs of the removal of such encroachments.

SECTION 3 REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES

All ordinances and parts of ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage and approval of this ordinance and in conflict therewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4 WHEN OPERATIVE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
