

ORDINANCE NO. 211

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAIG, NEBRASKA, REGULATING THE USE OF THE STREETS OF SAID VILLAGE FOR STORAGE OF MATERIAL USED IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF BUILDINGS ADJACENT THERETO; THE OBTAINING OF PERMIT THEREFOR; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PRESCRIBING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAIG, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1           STORING BUILDING MATERIAL IN STREETS;  
PERMIT

Any persons engaged in constructing, repairing, or wrecking any building or structure in said village may occupy street or sidewalk space adjacent to such building or structure with building material and equipment for a limited time if such person shall first obtain written permit therefor from the Street Commissioner; provided no permit shall be granted for the occupancy of more than one-third of the adjacent roadway, and provided further that a suitable and safe passageway for pedestrians shall be provided and maintained at all times by the builder. Any persons using the sidewalk or street for the above purpose shall be liable to the village for any damage recovered against the village by any person on account of any such obstruction so placed in any street or sidewalk space.

SECTION 2           REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES

All ordinances and parts of ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage and approval of this ordinance and in conflict therewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3           WHEN OPERATIVE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
