

## ORDINANCE NO. 213

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAIG, NEBRASKA, IMPOSING AN OCCUPATION TAX UPON FIRE INSURANCE COMPANIES DOING BUSINESS IN SAID VILLAGE, FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR THE METHOD OF COLLECTING THE SAME; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PRESCRIBING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAIG, NEBRASKA:

### SECTION 1           AMOUNT OF TAX; WHEN DUE

An occupation tax of five dollars per annum is hereby levied upon each and every fire insurance company doing business in the Village of Craig, Nebraska, for the use and benefit of the Volunteer Fire Department of said village, which said tax shall become due and payable on the first day of May of each year hereafter.

### SECTION 2           LOCAL AGENT TO PAY TAX; ACTION TO ENFORCE PAYMENT

It shall be the duty of the local agents of such companies to pay said tax for each company represented by them and in default of the payment thereof at the time it is due, an action may be brought by said village against such company or its local agent, or both, for the collection of said tax.

### SECTION 3           TO WHOM PAID; DEPOSIT IN FIRE FUND

Said tax shall be payable to the Village Clerk who shall forthwith upon the receipt thereof, pay the same over to the Village Treasurer for credit to the Fire Fund of said village.

### SECTION 4           REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES

All ordinances and parts of ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage and approval of this ordinance and in conflict therewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5            WHEN OPERATIVE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
