

ORDINANCE NO. 215

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAIG, NEBRASKA, RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF RAILROADS IN SAID VILLAGE; PROHIBITING THE OBSTRUCTION OF THE STREETS BY TRAINS, CARS OR LOCOMOTIVES; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PRESCRIBING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAIG, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1 RAILROADS TO KEEP CROSSINGS SAFE; PENALTY

It shall be the duty of each railroad company operating in said Village to keep that part of the streets and alleys which are intersected by the tracks and the right of way of such railroad in a safe condition for public travel over and across the same; and if said railroad company shall fail to repair the same for a period of five days after written notice from the Street Commissioner to do so, upon conviction it shall be fined not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$100.00.

SECTION 2 OBSTRUCTING CROSSINGS PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any railroad company, its agents or employees or any other person to cause or permit any locomotive, car or train to be or remain upon any street or railroad crossing within said Village for a period longer than five minutes at one time, except that in case of an emergency the company shall be allowed a reasonable time to remove such obstruction. In all prosecutions for a violation of this section the depot agent or other chief officer of such railroad company in said Village, as well as any engineer, fireman, conductor, brakeman, or other person taking part in the moving of such locomotive, car or train causing an obstruction to any street, or whose duty it is to move the same shall be deemed and considered severally responsible for such violation.

SECTION 3 PENALTY

Any persons who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not more than \$100.00 and shall pay the costs of prosecution.

SECTION 4 REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES

All ordinances and parts of ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage and approval of this ordinance and in conflict therewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5 WHEN OPERATIVE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
