

ORDINANCE NO. 216

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAIG, NEBRASKA, DEFINING THE TERM "LICENSED PLUMBER" AND PROVIDING THE PROCEDURE FOR LICENSING OF PLUMBERS IN SAID VILLAGE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PRESCRIBING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAIG, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1 LICENSED PLUMBER DEFINED

The term "licensed plumber" as used in the ordinances of the Village of Craig, Nebraska, is hereby defined to denote any person to whom a plumber's license has been duly issued or renewed, as hereinafter provided, which has not been revoked or terminated by lapse of time.

SECTION 2 PROCEDURE TO OBTAIN LICENSE

Any person wishing to obtain a license as a plumber shall file in the office of the Village Clerk an application, in writing, asking to become a licensed plumber and stating his willingness to be governed in all respects by the ordinances of said Village and all rules and regulations now in effect or hereafter to be adopted by said Village concerning the water and sewer systems of said Village. Such application shall be presented by the Village Clerk to the Board at its next meeting thereafter held, and upon the Board being satisfied of the business capacity, qualifications, and good reputation of the application, and of his worthiness to receive a license, and upon his payment to the Village Clerk of a license fee of \$5.00 and his filing with the Village Clerk of a bond with corporate surety to be approved by the Board, in the penal sum of \$2,000.00, conditioned upon his indemnifying and keeping harmless the Village of Craig, Nebraska, from all liability for any damage arising from any negligence or unskillful act in doing or protecting his work, or from any unfaithful or inadequate work done in pursuance of his license, and conditioned that he will restore the streets, alleys, sidewalks and pavements over the pipes he may lay, and fill all excavations made by him so as to leave said streets, alleys, sidewalks, and pavements in as good condition as he found them, and keep and maintain the same in good order to the satisfaction of the Street Commissioner for the period of one year next thereafter and that he will pay all fines that may be imposed upon him for a violation

of any of the ordinances, rules, and regulations adopted by said Village, and in force during the term of his license, said Board may grant to such applicant a license to be issued by the Village Clerk, authorizing the applicant to engage in business as a licensed plumber in said Village for and during the then current municipal year. Said license and bond shall cover all employees of the applicant.

SECTION 3 RENEWAL OF LICENSES

Any license granted as provided in the preceding section may be renewed from year to year, at the option of the Village Board, on application therefor, and upon payment of the license fee of \$5.00 for the year and the renewal of applicant's bond.

SECTION 4 TERM OF LICENSE

The term of each license or renewal may be revoked at any time, at the option of the Village Board.

SECTION 5 FEES TO BE PAID TO VILLAGE TREASURER

The Village Clerk shall pay over to the Village Treasurer all license fees collected by him pursuant to this ordinance.

SECTION 6 REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT

All ordinances and parts of ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage and approval of this ordinance and in conflict therewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7 WHEN OPERATIVE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
