

ORDINANCE NO. 218

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAIG, NEBRASKA, REGULATING PEDDLING WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF CRAIG AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPLICATION FOR A PEDDLER'S PERMIT; IMPOSING A FINE AND PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PRESCRIBING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAIG, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1 PERMITS

No person shall go in and upon private residences in this Village for the purposes of selling goods, wares and merchandise or the taking of orders for the same, without first having procured a permit therefor from the Village Clerk. To get such a permit, application must be made on forms provided by the Village Clerk for that purpose which shall be in substance as follows:

When the application has been properly executed and a certificate of a duly licensed physician executed on or within thirty days preceding the date of submission of the application to the effect that the applicant has no infectious, contagious or communicable disease is furnished, the Village Clerk shall make an investigation of the applicant's character and integrity, and if he finds it satisfactory shall issue the permit requested.

SECTION 2 REVOCATION

The permit referred to in Section 1 of this code shall be valid for six months unless sooner revoked. Such a permit may be revoked by the Village Clerk after notice and hearing for the following reasons:

- (1) Fraud, misrepresentation or false statement contained in the application for permit;
- (2) Fraud, misrepresentation or false statement made in the course of carrying on his business as a peddler;
- (3) Conviction of any crime or misdemeanor involving moral turpitude;
- (4) Conducting the business of peddling in an unlawful manner or in such a manner as to constitute a breach of the peace or to constitute a menace to the health, safety or general welfare of the public.

Notice of the hearing shall be given in writing, setting forth specifically the grounds of complaint and the time and place of hearing, which notice shall be personally served on the permittee by a policeman designated by the Village Clerk for that purpose at least 24 hours prior to the time set for hearing, or shall be mailed to the permittee at his last known address at least five days prior to said time.

SECTION 3 PENALTY

Any permittee furnishing false information on or in connection with his application shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, on conviction of which he shall be fined \$100.00 and assessed the court costs of prosecution. Any other violation of the provisions of this article shall be deemed a misdemeanor, on conviction of which the offender shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$100.00 and assessed the court costs of prosecution.

SECTION 4 EXCEPTIONS

The provisions of Sections 1, 2, and 3 of this ordinance shall not apply to persons selling vegetables, fruit, eggs, poultry, meat, garden truck, farm products, or provisions produced on their own premises.

SECTION 5 REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT

All ordinances and parts of ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage and approval of this ordinance and in conflict therewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6 WHEN OPERATIVE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
