

ORDINANCE NO. 221

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAIG, NEBRASKA, REQUIRING PROPERTY OWNERS AND OCCUPANTS TO REMOVE WEEDS, GRASS, AND OTHER VEGETATION FROM THEIR PREMISES AND CURB PARKING ADJACENT THERETO WHEN THE SAME IS OR MAY BECOME A FIRE HAZARD; PROHIBITING THE BURNING OF PAPER OR COMBUSTIBLE MATERIALS IN CERTAIN AREAS OF SAID VILLAGE, EXCEPT IN AN APPROVED INCINERATOR; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PRESCRIBING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAIG, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1 WEEDS, REMOVAL OF

It shall be the duty of the occupants of each lot or parcel of land within said Village to remove all weeds, grass and other vegetation from such premises and the parking adjacent thereto extending from sidewalk to curb, when the same is or may become a fire hazard, and if the owner or occupant of any such lot or parcel of land shall fail to remove such grass, weeds, or other vegetation from said premises or curb parking within five days after having received written notice, he shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction he shall be fined as hereinafter prescribed, and it shall be the duty of the Street Commissioner to cause such grass, weeds or other vegetation to be removed from such premises or curb parking at the expense of the occupant, or owner which amount shall be included in the penalty assessed.

SECTION 2 PENALTY

Any person violating any of the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance, upon conviction shall be fined not more than \$10.00 and pay the costs of prosecution.

SECTION 3 REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES

All ordinances and parts of ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage and approval of this ordinance and in conflict therewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4 WHEN OPERATIVE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
