

and each layer shall be thoroughly tamped and puddled. The streets, sidewalks and pavements must be restored to as good condition as previous to making excavations. All dirt, stones, and rubbish must be removed immediately after completion of the work. If an excavation in any street, alley or highway shall be left open or unfinished for the space of twenty-four hours, or if the work shall be improperly done or if the rubbish shall not be removed, the Water Commissioner shall have the right to finish or correct the work, and the expenses incurred shall be charged to the consumer and shall be paid by the plumber, drainlayer or other person authorized by consumer to do the excavating work or by consumer before the water is turned on. No main shall be tapped or connections made when the ground is frozen, except by special permission of the Water Commissioner. No person shall make any excavation in any streets or highway within six feet of any laid water pipe while the ground is frozen or dig up or uncover so as to expose to the frost any water pipe of this Village except under direction of the Water Commissioner.

SECTION 19 LEAKAGE

Any consumer having knowledge of leaking pipes on his own premises or between the commercial main and said premises shall cause them to be repaired as soon as reasonably possible. It shall be the duty of all policemen forthwith to report to the Water Commissioner any leaking pipes anywhere in this Village of which they have knowledge.

SECTION 20 FIRE HYDRANTS

All hydrants erected by said Village for the purpose of extinguishing fire are hereby declared to be public hydrants, and no person or persons other than members of the fire department in the active discharge of their duties as such, or the Water Commissioner, or some person acting directly through his order, shall open said hydrants or attempt to draw water from the same or at any time uncover or remove any protection from any of said hydrants or in any manner interfere with the same; and no person authorized to open hydrants shall delegate his authority to another, or let out, or suffer any person to take the wrenches in his possession or control, or suffer the same to be taken from any house in said Village except for a purpose strictly connected with the Fire

Department, or as they may accompany fire apparatus on occasion of fire.

SECTION 21 WATER STEALING

No person shall tamper with any meter for the purpose of causing it to read inaccurately, nor attempt by any means to divert water from the service pipe so that it will not pass through the proper meter, nor to procure water from the water works for any premises while the water service thereto is disconnected for non-payment of water rates or pursuant to Section 26 of this ordinance.

SECTION 22 WATER WASTE

No person shall deliberately waste water. The Water Commissioner may make and publish such regulations as he deems necessary to determine what constitutes deliberate waste of water, but such regulations when made shall apply uniformly throughout the Village.

SECTION 23 NOT OBLIGATED OUTSIDE CORPORATE LIMITS

The Village is not obligated to furnish water service to premises outside the corporate limits and shall not unless it is able to do so without overloading its pumps and without curtailing any reasonable use of water within the corporate limits of the Village.

SECTION 24 PLUMBING RESTRICTIONS

No person other than the Water Commissioner or his assistant or a licensed plumber under his direction shall set meters, tap commercial mains or make a connection to the water service of this Village. No person shall install plumbing or water service in this Village except in conformity with the National Plumbing Code.

SECTION 25 OFFICERS TO REPORT VIOLATION

It shall be the duty of the police officers of said Village to report to the Water Commissioner all cases

of leakage, waste or unnecessary profusion in the use of water, and all violations of this or any other ordinance relating to the water works of said Village that may be brought to their notice, and they shall enforce the observance of all such ordinances so far as they have authority to do so.

SECTION 26 PENALTY

Any person violating any provision of any section of this ordinance, including the regulations promulgated by the Water Commissioner under Sections 14 and 22 shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not less than one dollar, nor more than \$100.00, and assessed the court costs of prosecution, and, if the person convicted is a consumer, the Water Commissioner, if so directed by resolution of the Chairman and Board, shall disconnect the water service to him until he furnishes satisfactory assurance that he will not violate such provision in the future and pays a reinstatement fee of two dollars.

SECTION 27 REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES

All ordinances and parts of ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage and approval of this ordinance and in conflict therewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 28 WHEN OPERATIVE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
